

## Greetings from CPC - Spring 2017,

Spring is fighting off the last vestiges of winter and we are looking forward to the arrival of our summer friends and members. We want to give you all a quick update on life here at CPC.

The **Little Rangers Learning Center** began using our facility on February 1. It has been an adjustment for us, but our willingness to host the learning center has been well received by our community. On any given day, there are around 30+ children and 8-10 workers here. ### A Quick Summary of events so far this year....

- This year for **Christmas Eve**, we integrated the nativity scene with the scripture and carols. Everyone seemed to enjoy and was blessed.
- **Good Friday Evening** was a “come-and-go” Meditative and Reflective Worship experience of 5 stations from 6:30-8:00 pm. The written and spoken Word of God, along with visual imagery and symbolic acts provided opportunities to reflect on the grace, mercy and love of God made available to us through Christ’s sacrificial death on the Cross. It was our hope and prayer that this event helped to prepare hearts for the joyous reality of Easter Morning and the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
- **Sunrise Easter Service** was again at the old Davis residence at Duck Creek with our Baptist Church friends. For the first time, we actually got to see the sun rise on that beautiful clear Easter morning. After an opening prayer from Pastor Benny and a “fly by” by the geese, Pastor Bob read the story of the resurrection from the Gospel of Matthew. It reminded us of how shocking the empty tomb was for those who were present that resurrection morning. We had a potluck breakfast at CPC and then the later morning service at 10 am.
- The **Thursday Family Night** dinner and youth groups have been well attended.
- We still offer two Women’s **Bible study groups** each week. One is on Tuesday at 3:30 and the other on Wednesdays at 9:30. Sunday mornings, our Adult Bible Study has been working through Hebrews.
- On Wednesdays at noon, we have a scheduled time for **corporate prayer**. We encourage all to come together for the needs of the church and our community.
